TRAVELLING INSTRUCTION TO NÖTÖ

ONE DAY TRIP (MONDAY, TUESDAY, WEDNESDAY)

LOCATION AND FERRY-TRIP

The island of Nötö is located in the middle of the Archipelago National Park about 20 km from Nauvo to the south. The island is reachable by ferry MS Baldur. Ferry departs from Nauvo's Pärnäs on **Monday and Tuesday** at 8.30 and arrives to Nötö around 10.00. On **Wednesday** ferry departs from Pärnäs at 11.10 and arrives to Nötö at 12.50

Back to Pärnäs MS Baldur leaves on Monday from Nötö at 16.30 and arrives to Pärnäs at 18.15. On Tuesday and Wednesday ferry leaves from Nötö at 19.00 and arrives to Pärnäs at 20.30. Ferry trip to the island is free of charge.

HOW TO GET TO PÄRNÄS

Pärnäs (also Pärnäinen) in Nauvo can be reached from Turku by The archipelago bus 901-904. Daily morning bus (*Skärgårdsbuss 902*) departs from Turku Bus Station at 6.40 and arrives to Pärnäs at 8.23. On Wednesday good connection to catch ferry is a bus from Turku at 9.10 arriving to Pärnäs at 10.53. Ferry waits the bus to arrive.

On Mondays you can travel back to Parainen/Pargas from Pärnäs by minibus, departure after ferry has arrived. From Parainen onward connection by local bus to Turku. **NOTE!** There is no bus connection from the evening ferry on Tuesdays and Wednesdays.

Pärnäs harbour can also be reached via the Archipelago road by own car. Calculate for a car trip from Turku minimum 2.5 hours, islands connecting ferry can cause delay. There is a free parking in harbour.
